Day 2

Colombo to Kandy via Pinnawela elephant orphanage

After Breakfast check out from the hotel in Colombo and proceed to Kandy via visiting the famous Elephant orphanage or the elephant millennium village / Spice garden



Tourists can observe and walk with the elephants at MEF as well as assist with their daily washing in the Kuda Oya River that runs through the grounds. The funds generated from both visitors and volunteers is used to maintain the elephant's well-being, and to enable the care and rescue of more captive elephants. MEF ensures that it strictly abides by the guidelines set by the Sri Lanka Tourism Development Authority. Since its inception, MEF has cared for more than 80 elephants. As of 2022, there are nine elephants, spanning in age from 15 to 53 years, under the care of the sanctuary. Pooja, one of the resident elephants, was the first elephant in the country to be born in captivity. MEF also runs the Footsteps Elephant Consultancy, the only mahout training program to be recognized and accredited by the Sri Lankan Department of Wildlife.

Elephant Orphanage at Pinnawela

Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage (PEO); just as the name suggests holds a unique disposition in the ex-situ animal care. It's success and fame has travelled not just within the country but throughout the world to an extent where Pinnawala synonymous with the Sri Lankan Elephant.

Currently being a home to 93 elephants the concept was actualized by the late Hon. Minister Kalugalle on the 16th of February 1975. Pinnawala at the time was a very remote area with lush coconut plantations and most importantly an area where the availability of mahouts was not lacking. Also the immense amount of water required by the elephants is supplemented with the availability of "Ma oya" running close by

Millennium Elephant Foundation, which has been home to the Samarasinghe family and their elephants for many generations, was first opened to the public as the Club Concept Elephant Bath in 1979 by Sam

Damro possess over 5,000 hectares of lush tea plantations, spread across all major tea-growing regions in Sri Lanka, from the low lying valleys of Sabaragamuwa to the central hills at elevations exceeding 1,500 meters. Ramboda Sri Lanka

Ramboda is a village in Sri Lanka. It is located within Central Province. The Ramboda Road Tunnel is currently the longest road tunnel in Sri Lanka and is situated on the A5 highway, close to Ramboda falls. It is 225 m long, 7 m wide and 5.6 m high

Ramboda Falls so named due to its proximity the breathtaking Ramboda Falls waterfall in Nuwara Eliya. guests enjoy beautiful views of nature's own wonderful creations when they stay at our well-planned holiday resort which is carefully built on a precipice.

The salubrious climate has branded Nuwara Eliya into a sanatorium that attracts Sri Lankan tourists as well as foreign travellers to the seasonal event during February to April. Golf tournaments, horse racing, motor cross, clay pigeon shooting and carnival features are some of the main festivities. The downside of the season is the accommodation rates that shoot up above all. With thousands of local tourists flocking to Nuwara Eliya filling up hotels and guest houses that provide budget accommodation in the season and narrowing the accommodation options, foreign tourists would find it necessary to have the hotel bookings sorted out well in advance.

Eagles View Point Nuwaraeliya

The Eagles' Viewpoint, a newly established scenic overlook in Shanthipura village—the highest elevated village in Sri Lanka's Nuwara Eliya District—offers stunning panoramic views of the picturesque landscape. Visitors can marvel at the rolling hills covered in vibrant tea plantations, lush greenery, and the majestic backdrop of distant mountain ranges.

AMBEWELA FARM

There are two farms at Ambewela and those are called New Zealand farm and Ambewela farms. New Zealand farm is at 1km from Ambewela and Ambewela farm is at before Ambewela. Rabbits, Cattles, Cows, Goats and grass lands, vegetable farm, seed potatoes producing center and nice reservoir are available on Ambewela

farm. No special permission needed to enter Ambewela Farms. In 12:30 PM of every day demonstrates the get cow milk in electronic machine. Cheese factory, Goat yard and thousands of animals can be seen in Ambewela farms. Largest grass lands of Sri Lanka also a part of Ambewela farms

Nuwaraeliya to the Booked beach resort

Sri Lanka is a land of waterfalls with 103 rivers and streams, whereby the country boasts of the highest waterfall density in the world. However, only a small number of waterfalls can be viewed with ease since the majorities are positioned amidst thick lush forests and tea plantations.

The 265 feet high, St. Clair's fall is among those that can be viewed easily and is one of the most beautiful waterfalls of the country. St. Claris is also renowned as the widest and the 20th highest in Sri Lanka. The name of this unique natural treasure derived from a tea estate located close by. The most important feature of St. Clair's fall is that it consists of two waterfalls, namely Maha Ella and Kuda Ella.

Falling in three uninterrupted cascades is the Maha Ella which is the larger one that flows down to Kothmale fall. The Maha Ella is 80 meters high. The smaller one which is known as the Kuda Ella is 60 meters high. The Kuda Ella also flows to the Kothmale fall.

Positioned 3 kilometers west from Talawakele town, St. Clair's fall can be easily viewed from A-7 road as well as the nearby railway line. Although most people prefer to witness the waterfall from the road at a distant, it is always better to head closer in order to get a glimpse of its true beauty. Travelers can reach St. Clair's fall through a beautiful tea plantation. / Reach the beach resort and rest of the time for leisure by the pool or beach

The Bentota River is a beautiful river teeming with wildlife. Spend a morning exploring the mangrove, river banks and lily clad islands on the search for prehistoric creatures such as monitor lizards, crocodiles and the beautiful birds of prey which patrol the area. You may also see the rivers sand digger boats and hand pulled ferry. You may row around mangroves along the Bentota River watching birds of many different hues,

crocodiles, reptiles. During the one-day tour you may visit Cinnamon Island and some temples also take a panoramic view of the eco diversity.

Bentota River

River Bentota, the legendary river in southern part of the country, flows into the Indian Ocean forming a lagoon at the last section of the river. The River Bentota and the lagoon set up the widest array of water sports among all the beach resorts of Sri Lanka. Jet-skiing, windsurfing, parasailing or enjoying a romantic river safari along the clam waters are some of the activities that are well known in the area. It has an amazing bio-diversity with all to be experienced within walking distance. Bentota River Boat Safari is more popular and well known for the tourists for witnessing crocodiles in their wild habitat as well as witnessing the amazing aquatic species, fauna & flora of the Bentota River.

Turtle Hatchery

There are a few turtle hatcheries along the beach between Induruwa and Ahungalla. Some are very small (a few basins on the beach) while others are of a decent size. The most interesting one is located on the beach behind the Kosgoda Police Station.

Kosgoda Sea Turtle Sanctuary does not only gather the turtle eggs to let them hatch and release the turtles as soon as they are ready to go out to sea, they also take care of wounded and sick species and provide schools and students with turtle-related items for use in classes. All the money received from entrance fees and donations is used entirely to buy the turtle eggs from the locals (who would otherwise eat the eggs) and maintain the infrastructure
